The Award

Founded by SSDS; Scholarships are available for deserving students for tuition assistance in honor and perpetuate the memory of Madison Burrell, who loved dance more than anything.

Eligibility

- x Applicant must be a current SSDS dance student and must be registered with SSDS for the upcoming dance season.
- x Applicant must have danced with SSDS for at least one full dance year.
- x Applicant must be willing to accept responsibility of the scholarship and complete a full dance year at SSDS, representing the studio, dancers and staff appropriately.
- x Selection is based on the applicant's attendance, attitude, and effort in class; treatment of and respect for instructors and fellow dance students; citizenship; leadership; and scholastic achievement.

Application Process

- x Complete the form in its entirety and answer all questions as thoroughly as possible (use extra paper if needed).
- x Please print as neatly as possible (or type).
- x Applicant **and** parent or legal guardian must sign the Certification and Release Authorization at the end of the form.
- x All applications must be returned to the SSDS office no later than October 1, 2016.
- x The number of scholarship(s) is determined each year by the funds raised.
- X All scholarship recipients will be notified in writing, and posted on SSDS website.
- x Your application represents you! We will ask your dance instructors and peers questions about you as a student and may observe your effort, actions and behavior during and outside of class.
- x This is not about being the best technical dancer or performer; it's about being a good person, student, citizen, friend, mentor, etc.; showing hard work and improvement, and exhibiting a passion for what you do.
